HONOREE

HONORABLE JOHN C. LIU

John C. Liu is a New York State Senator representing a broad area of northeast Queens. He is chairperson of the Senate's committee on New York City Education and also serves on the committees of Education, Finance, Higher Education, Judiciary, Rules and Transportation. John was Comptroller of the City of New York (2010-2013) and a New York City Councilmember (2002-2009). In 2013, John was a candidate for Mayor of New York City, in lieu of running for re-election as Comptroller. Currently, John teaches municipal finance and public policy in Masters programs at the City University of New York (CUNY) and Columbia University.

The 43rd Comptroller of New York City, John Liu established an impressive record as the chief financial officer for 8.4 million residents and overseeing municipal government with an annual budget of \$70 billion. John saved taxpayers \$5 billion through rigorous audits of City agencies, detailed scrutiny of contracts with private companies, and refinancing of \$20 billion of outstanding City bond debt. During his four-year term of office, he achieved an enviable total investment return, increasing the City's pension asset portfolio to \$150 billion. John created the nationally acclaimed online application "CheckbookNYC.com" providing unprecedented transparency in government spending. He facilitated economic development and new job creation with acceleration of City capital projects, capturing low interest rates in the bond markets.

Always emphasizing that "it's not just about numbers, it's about people," John Liu championed fairness and equality. An early and staunch opponent of stop-and-frisk tactics, John highlighted the risks to communities and taxpayers alike due to damaged police-community relations. John presented dailyupdated M/WBE Report Cards for City agencies to monitor and encourage greater government contracting opportunities for minority entrepreneurs. John also proposed sound economic policies to create real economic growth and narrow the ever-widening wealth gap, protected wage standards and recouped back wages and fines on behalf of cheated workers from contractors who just don't want to play by the rules, and exposed the billions of dollars in publicly-subsidized corporate welfare doled out by the City that failed to deliver on promised new jobs and fair housing. He published numerous reports analyzing and issuing recommendations on a wide range of public priorities, including education and the need to take students beyond high school, affordable housing and family support, retirement security and protection of pension benefits, and the fiscal and social benefits of legalizing marijuana. As a member of the New York City Council, John Liu represented his hometown of Flushing and northeast Queens. He secured millions of dollars in additional funding for schools, libraries, parks, senior citizen centers, and youth programs. John served as chairperson of the Council's Transportation Committee overseeing operations of the Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Department of Transportation, and Taxi and Limousine Commission, and enacted legislation boosting efficiency and efficacy of key



John also served on the committees on Education, Consumer Affairs, Contracts, Oversight & Investigation, Land Use, Lower Manhattan Redevelopment and Health.

John's significant accomplishments as a legislator included exposing financial irregularities at the MTA, enacting legislation like the Equal Access Bill mandating on-demand language services in health and human services agencies, the School Zone Engine Idling Bill limiting engine idling near schools, and the Dignity for All Schools Act requiring the Department of Education to track bullying and harassment in schools. John used his office to fight hate and bigotry, and in too many instances denounced violence against immigrant workers such as restaurant delivery workers. John's battles with radio shock-jocks and their corporate sponsors successfully brought an end to extreme racist and misogynist broadcasts in the New York market.

Hailed as a "Trailblazer" and "Pioneer," John Liu's historic elections – as the first Asian American to win legislative office in New York and then the first to win citywide office – were milestones for Asian Americans in New York and across the nation. Although he wishes Asian Americans had been elected long before, John is honored to be the first and embraces the opportunity to broaden representation and public service.

Prior to being elected to office, John worked in the private sector for 14 years as a professional actuary, most recently as a manager at PricewaterhouseCoopers. John has drawn upon his real world fiscal expertise to root out waste and mismanagement in government. John Liu immigrated from Taiwan at the age of five. He was educated in New York public schools, including Hunter College High School, Bronx High School of Science, and Binghamton University, attaining his degree in Mathematical Physics. John lives in Flushing with his wife Jenny and their son Joey

HONOREE HON. ELIZABETH CROWLY

Elizabeth Crowley has a long and robust history of public service and work in construction and community development. Crowley served on the New York City Council, representing the city legislature's 30th District in Queens from 2009 to 2017. As a member of the New York City Council, she successfully fought for a record amount of funding for construction of schools and

passed laws that strengthened construction safety standards, expanded opportunities for Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises, and funded programs that provided industry training including Nontraditional Employment for Women. Crowley also supported major land-use and zoning amendments allowing for major expansions including Hudson Yards and Midtown East. Prior to joining BTEA, Crowley was a board chair and co-founder of a non-profit group "21 in 21" — renamed "The New Majority." The organization was dedicated to bringing more gender parity into the City Council. The effort succeeded in establishing the first female majority in the legislative body. Before her election to the NYC Council, Crowley worked in the construction industry as a decorative painter with District Council 9 on landmark restorations including Radio City Music Hall, the Central Synagogue and St. Patrick's Cathedral. She also spent years managing workforce and education programs that trained union members and workers throughout the diverse communities of NYC.




Crowley serves on the boards of several important organizations, including the New York Building Congress, Non-Traditional Employment for Women, New American Voters Association, Helmets to Hardhats and the Edward J. Malloy Initiative for Construction Skills. Crowley holds a Master of Science Degree from Pratt Institute's Graduate Center for Planning and Environmental Science from the School of Architecture, as well as a Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree in Art Restoration from the Fashion Institute of Technology (SUNY). She resides in Queens with her two sons, Dennis and Owen.

HONOREE

LOIS MARBACH

Lois Marbach has a history of community activism and of being an Advocate for Women's Rights, and many social issues while fighting for Equality and Justice. In 1976 she was the Founder, organizer and coordinator of a not for profit

Women's Center in Queens. Certified in Peer Counseling, Suicide Intervention and Domestic Violence support, she ran a suicide prevention hot line and facilitated various rap groups and consciousness raising groups. She has also served as the Legislative Director of the Queens National Organization for Women and President of the Queens Women's Political Caucus. She is proud to have served as a Commissioner on the NYC Commission on the Status of Women and the Board of Directors of New York NARAL. Lois was a Candidate for NYS Senate in 1982 and Queens Borough President in 1986. She is a former Chairperson of the Queens New Democratic Coalition (NDC) and former Vice President of NYS NDC as well as the Chairperson of the Queens Coalition for Political Alternatives. She served as President of both the Eastern Queens Democratic Club and the Queens County Progressive Democratic Club. Lois is a former Member of Community Board 11, and served for 10 years on the Board of Trustees of the Queens Borough Public Library. Lois is a former Commissioner on the Workers Rights Board. Lois Marbach is currently President of her local Civic Association the Oakland Gardens/Terrace Community Council and is the Founder of Progressive Voices United/Democratic Coalition, a political organization started in 2017. Lois is also a Founding Board Member of Hearts of Change.



Lois is a Democratic Political Consultant for socially conscious candidates and elected officials. As the owner of Promotional Strategies she oversees marketing, promotion and advertising campaigns for unions, not-for profits, small businesses and organizes special events such as conferences and fundraising dinners and journals. Lois currently works for NYC Council Member Linda Lee as a Community Liaison. Among other groups Lois has been honored by: Recipient Aaron Weiss Humanitarian Award Flushing NAACP

LAMAR HUGHES

Lamar Hughes has spent 23 years building a successful career in education, labor, and political action. His journey has underscored the importance of providing quality education for children while empowering staff members to deliver their best.

Lamar began his teaching career at P.S. 118 in District 29, where he formed lasting relationships with colleagues and met his wife, Alyson. He later transferred to P.S. 201 in District 25, where he developed new skills and laid the foundation for his next step as a labor organizer. His hard work and dedication led to him being honored as the 2015 Teacher of the Year by Assemblyman Mike Simanowitz and The Stevenson Democratic Club.

As a member and representative of the United Federation of Teachers (UFT), Lamar has served in various capacities, including Chapter Leader, Convention Delegate, and Chapter Advocate. In 2019, he was appointed UFT Representative for District 25, representing 2,700 members across 36 schools in Northeast Queens. Lamar is also the UFT's Political Action Coordinator for Queens, playing a vital role in facilitating the union's political initiatives throughout "The World's Borough."



Lamar is a firm believer in leading by example and never asking anyone to do something he wouldn't do himself. He speaks with intention, conviction, and clarity, ensuring that his message is heard and understood. Lamar embraces discomfort, knowing that growth comes from challenging oneself. He understands the value of using his time wisely, a discipline that has been instrumental in his many achievements.

Lamar's journey is a testament to the power of hard work, dedication, and a constructive approach to problem-solving. His achievements inspire us all to strive for excellence while empowering others to do the same.

HONOREE THOMAS GRECH

Tom Grech was appointed Executive Director of the Queens Chamber of Commerce in July 2015 and became President and Chief Executive Officer on November 1, 2017. His career has spanned the printing and publishing industries over the past 25 years, with significant roles at RR Donnelley & Sons Company, Merrill Corporation, and SONY DADC.


In addition to his professional career, Tom has been actively involved in various organizations and community activities. He served as Past President of the University of Scranton National Alumni Society Board of Governors and was a Board Member of the Nassau Land Trust from 2010 to 2015. He has also been a Board Member of the Brooklyn and Queens Boy Scouts, Catholic Charities of Brooklyn & Queens, York College Foundation, Friends of the BQX, Inc., King Manor Museum, Cathedral Prep, and NYC PAL. Tom has co-chaired the LaGuardia AirTrain initiative and participated in the Sunnyside Yards Steering Committee, Western Queens Tech Council, Willets Point Redevelopment Steering Committee, JFK Redevelopment Community Advisory Council, and Amazon Community Advisory Committee.



Additionally, he is a Member of the New York City Regional Economic Development Council and a Board Member of the Business Incubator Association of New York State. He also serves as Vice Chair of the Town of Hempstead IDA/LDC.

Originally from Astoria, Queens, Tom is a graduate of the University of Scranton in Scranton, PA, with a BS in Accounting. He also holds an MBA in International Business from Manhattan College in Riverdale, NY.

Freedom fighter Dr. Masudul
Hassan is a renowned
cardiologist. He has worked as a
cardiologist in the UK,
Bangladesh, UAE and USA. He
is a professor and director of
the Metropolitan Learning
Institute in New York.

During the Liberation war in1971, he fought for independence for the motherland. His father was brutally killed by the Pakistani occupation forces. He was also a victim of torture. This heroic freedom fighter is also active in politics. He was also of the Central Committee of the United States Awami League for a long time. Currently, he is the president of the United States Sheikh Kamal Smriti Parishad. Durig the Covid-19 pandemic Dr. Masudul Hassan with another three doctors Dr. Zia, Dr. Hafiz, and Dr. Arif with Mr. Bappy sent vaccines and oxygen saturation machines and 850 ventilators free from the USA directly to Dhaka.
